

Suggested Supply list for all oil painting courses/ Elizabeth Hutchinson

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Oil Colors:

White

Red:

Cadmium red

Alizarin crimson

Yellow:

Cadmium yellow deep Almost an orange color

Lemon yellow

Blue:

Ultramarine blue

Cerulean blue

Green:

Viridian

Earth Colors:

Red Iron Oxide (or other earth red)

Yellow ochre

Burnt sienna

Raw umber

Medium: Linseed oil

- ***Please no solvents since some may have allergies to these*
 - *Two small glass jars with screw on lids*
 - *Brushes: a selection of flats, sizes 1-4 , a small round*
 - *A roll of good paper towel ie: bounty*
 - *Palette: either a wooden one or the disposable/strip palettes are fine*
 - *Canvas or panels: two 8x10" and not larger than 12x 16"*
 - *A small notebook, pencil, pen and small sketch book and a painting apron*
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On the Spot art supplies

Dollar store:

- Zippered pouch aka pencil case to put everything in
- Plastic or other small jar with tight fitting lid
- Paper towel sheets folded in half (3 or 4)
- Pencil Sharpener that collects the shavings

Art Supply Store:

- Kneaded eraser
- Pencils , 4B, 2B
- Selection of small sketchbooks (I like Moleskins, but this is a really personal sort of thing, so you may like some other kind and that is perfect)
- Colored pencils, if you like them
- Ink Pen(s)(I like Micron Brand and especially like the brown fine tip one, but again, try a few, see above)
- Small box of watercolours (see above photo), any brand you like, but not the dollar store kind because the colours are not strong enough to work with)
- A few small watercolour brushes- one pointy one, one flat one
